### **NOTIFICATION OF ESSENTIAL MAINTENANCE WORKS M69 Southbound - M1 Junction 21 to M69 Junction 1**

I'm writing to let you know that we'll be carrying out essential maintenance works on the M69 Southbound - M1 Junction 21 to M69 Junction 1.

. During our scheme of work, we'll carry out;

- Carriageway resurfacing including sections of hard shoulder in a southbound direction.
- Refreshing of white lining and road studs on the southbound carriageway from M69 Junction 2 to Junction 1.

#### **When will the work take place?**

Work is due to start on **16<sup>th</sup> July 2024** and is scheduled for completion by **mid October 2024**.

Please note that all our planned roadworks may be subject to change due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.

#### **How will the work affect traffic?**

To keep our programme for these works as short as possible and to minimise disruption to the local community, residents, businesses and road users, we will be working under a full southbound carriageway closure including slip roads.

Closures will be in place between **8pm** and **6am, Monday to Friday**. Some weekend working may be required and will be advised once programme has been confirmed.

During these closures fully signed diversion routes will be in place, which have been agreed with the Local Authority.

### **How will the work affect businesses and residents?**

We will make sure that access to businesses and residences is maintained wherever possible.

We apologise for any inconvenience caused and will do our very best to complete the work as quickly as possible, keeping disturbances and noise to a minimum.

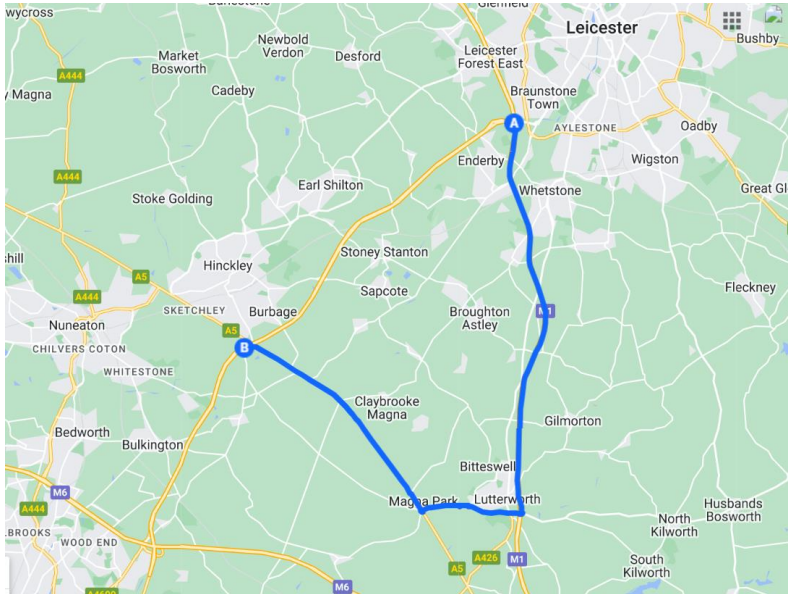

## Diversion Route

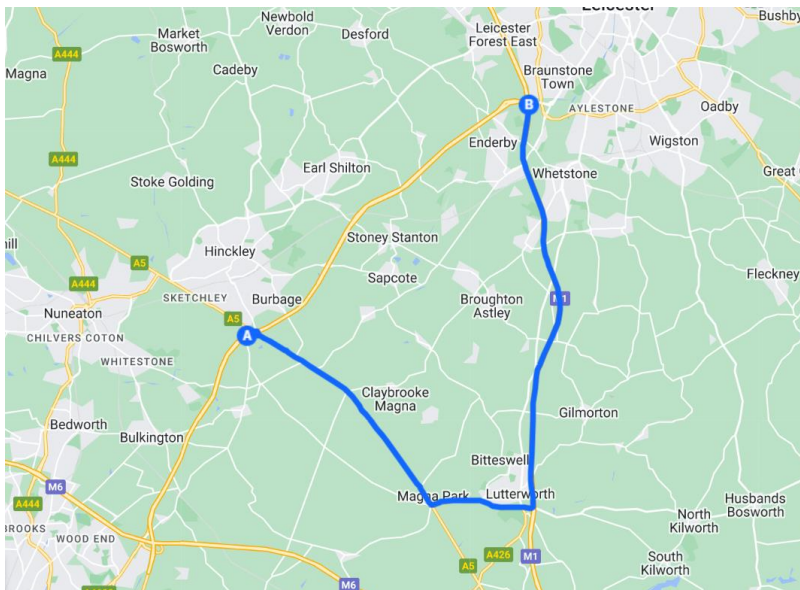
### M69 Southbound Diversion Route

Traffic wishing to travel southbound on the M69 will be diverted south on the M1 J21 until M1 J20. At the roundabout take the 2<sup>nd</sup> exit into the A4303 and travel west until the roundabout with the A5, at the roundabout take the 3<sup>rd</sup> exit onto the A5 North towards Hinckley, continue along the A5 until the roundabout with the M69. End of diversion.



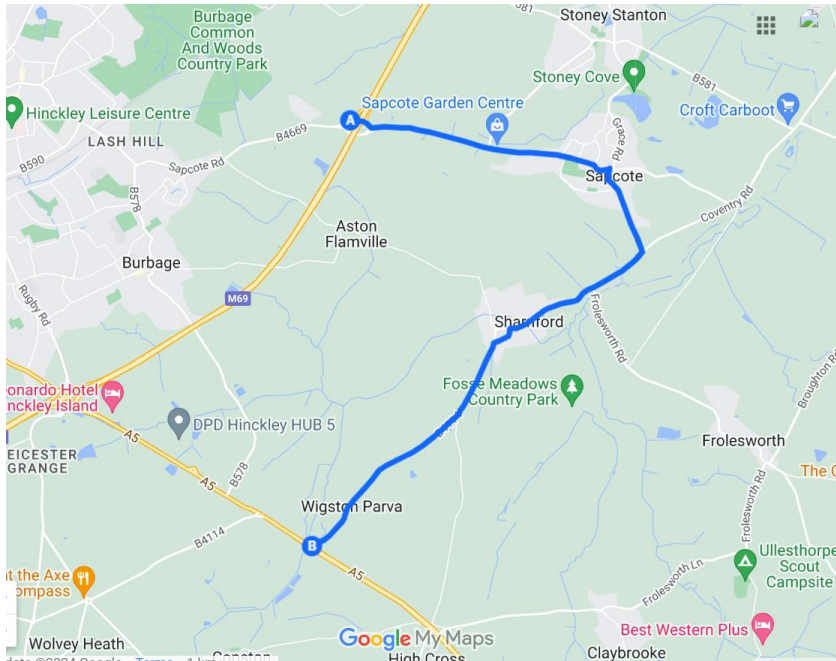
### M69 NB Diversion Route Junction 1

Traffic wishing to travel northbound on the M69 will be diverted south onto the A5 and will continue along the A5 south until the roundabout with the A4303. At the roundabout take the 1<sup>st</sup> exit and continue west until the roundabout with the M1 J20, at the roundabout take the 1<sup>st</sup> exit onto the M1 northbound. End of diversion.



## M69 NB Diversion Route Junction 2

Traffic wishing to travel north at junction 2 will be diverted onto the B4669 Hinckley Road, until its junction with Sharnford Road where it will turn right, at the junction with Sharnford Road and B4114 Coventry Road traffic will turn right, traffic will continue along B4114 Coventry Road until its junction with the A5 south, Turn left onto A5 south and follow diversion for M69 NB Junction 1. End of diversion.
