2022/054 To decide upon responses to planning applications received from Blaby District Council.

22/0472/RM strategic infrastructure to phase 2 subphase 3 – roads and drainage including ponds, swales and pumping station.

The Council commented that they were happy that cycle routes and crossings had been planned along Dee Way and Laxford Lane.

Decision: The council agree to support this application. The council would also like the following comments to be passed on to Blaby District Council.

- Given that the area off Dee Way is residential can parking bays be made along part
 of Dee Way to allow for occasional parking for visitors etc to deter people from
 parking on the road itself.
- Add double yellow lines along Dee Way to restrict parking on the road.
- The chicanes shown on Dee Way and Laxford Lane should have a priority show both with signs and road markings.
- Laxford Lane does not have a foot path next to the cycle path (on the south side) it is felt that it should have one.
- Should there be a provision for a bus stop along either or both of these roads as they will be quite major roads within the development.
- Can Dee Way and Laxford Lane have a 7.5 tonne limit and appropriate signage.
